INTRODUCTION

The Aligarh Unani Medical College and ACN Hospital was established in 1993 by Dr. R.A. Chaudhary a great reformist and an old scholar of Aligarh Muslim University under the auspices of AIRES Society.

The Aligarh Unani Medical College & ACN Hospital is an autonomous, non-profit making body from Aligarh Muslim University towards north on the Anoop Shahr Road leading to Kasimpur Power Plant.

The Unani college equipped with modern infrastructural and clinical systems has been established at ACN City. A well-connected bypass road has been constructed from the entrance in Aligarh at G.T. Road which leads straight to the Anoop Shahr Road avoiding city traffic congestion.

Aligarh is situated in the midst of U.P., the land between the Ganga and Yamuna Rivers at a distance of 110 km South-East of Delhi on the Delhi-Howrah Northern Rail Track and on the Grand Trunk Road. The latitude is 27° 54' N and the longitude is 78° 05' E. The climate is hot in summer and cold and dry in winter with an intervening rainy season.

The Institution is imparting Bachelor level Degree Courses in Unani Medicines (B.U.M.S.). The Courses are recognized by the National Council of Indian System of Medicine, New Delhi (N.C.I.S.M.) and affiliated with Mahayogi Guru Gorakhnath AYUSH University, Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh. P.G. level courses also started in Unani college.





Why the AUMC & ACN Hospital is different?

In short span of about 30 years of its existence, the institution has been able to pass out batches from 1993 to 2025 in Unani colleges. All students passed out in previous batches are well placed and enjoying a flourishing practice. Furthermore, the institution in the past has been selected for the allot-ment of successful candidates of CPMT amongst all the Self-Financed Medical Colleges of Unani Systems in Uttar Pradesh. The institution has also been selected as Nodal Institution to conduct entrance tests for admissions to the self financed Medical College of

Uttar Pradesh. The full-fledged Department of AYUSH Studies is fully equipped with Ultra modern clinical and learning facilities apart from **extensive infrastructure** as per the norms of the Central Council of Indian Medicine, (Government of India) New Delhi. Now NCISM

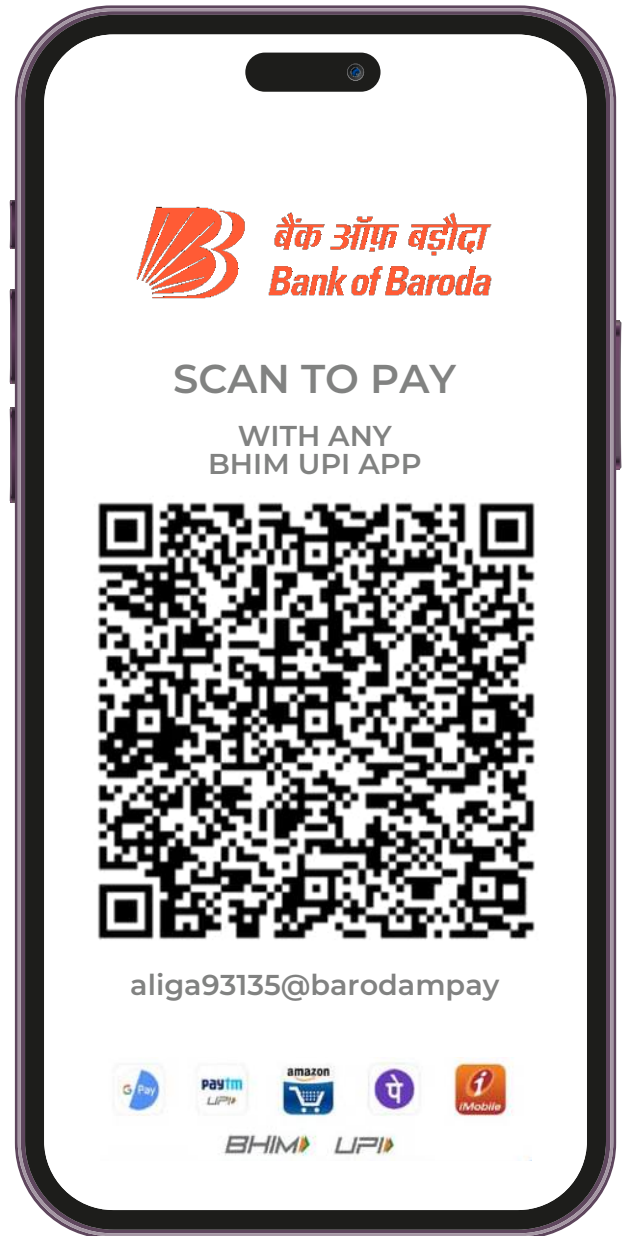

RULES AND REGULATIONS



FOR RESIDING IN THE HOSTEL OF A.U.M.C. (FOR GIRLS ONLY)

1. Room Allocation & Sharing:

- All rooms will accommodate a minimum of 3 students and a maximum of 4 students.
- Room sharing is mandatory- Any student refusing to share or causing problems with room sharing will be required to bear double the hostel expenses
- Room allocation is managed by the hostel authorities, and changes are permitted only under special circumstances, subject to approval.

2. Electricity & Power Backup:

- The hostel operates on government-provided electricity only. There is no power backup available except for study room.
- Students are encouraged to use electricity responsibly. ****Misuse or overuse**** will result in fines and penalties.

3. Fees & Payment:

- Hostel fees must be paid yearly in advance. No monthly payment options will be entertained.
- Non-payment or delayed payment of fees will result in suspension of hostel services until the dues are cleared.

4. Restricted Appliances:

- Heaters, induction stoves, and other high-wattage electrical appliances are strictly prohibited.
- Any student found in possession of or using these appliances will face fines and penalties as determined by hostel authorities.

5. Gender-Specific Regulations:

- Boys are strictly prohibited from entering the girls hostel under any circumstances. Violation of this rule will lead to immediate rustication from the college and hostel.
- Girls are not allowed to leave the hostel building after 7 PM, and they must not leave the campus premises after 6 PM. Violations of curfew timings will result in strict disciplinary action.
- Male relatives are not allowed to act as local guardians unless they are the real brother or father of the student.
- Girls are not permitted to leave the hostel premises without prior confirmation from their parents, either through email or telephone.

RULES AND REGULATIONS



FOR RESIDING IN THE HOSTEL OF A.U.M.C. (FOR GIRLS ONLY)

6. Discipline & Conduct:

- Students must respect the privacy and comfort of their roommates. Any form of misconduct or bullying will lead to disciplinary action.
- Possession or use of prohibited items such as drugs, alcohol, or weapons will result in severe disciplinary measures, including expulsion from the hostel.
- Smoking, alcohol consumption, or possession of alcohol inside or outside the hostel or college premises will result in immediate rustication, and a black Transfer Certificate (TC) will be issued. Any student even remotely involved in such activities will face severe disciplinary action, including rustication.

7. Visitors & Leave Policy:

- Visitors are allowed during specified hours and must be registered at the hostel office. Any unauthorized visitors will result in penalties.
- Girls are not allowed to leave the hostel alone unless prior parental permission is granted via email or telephone confirmation**.
- Students wishing to leave the hostel overnight or for an extended period must seek approval from the hostel warden. Unauthorized absences will result in penalties.

8. Security & Safety:

- Regular inspections will be conducted to ensure compliance with hostel rules, and any student found violating the rules will face strict consequences.
- Students must keep their rooms and shared spaces clean and report any maintenance issues promptly to the hostel management.

9. Maintenance of Hostel Property:

- Any damage caused to hostel property will be charged to the student(s) responsible. Students are expected to maintain their rooms and common areas in good condition.

10. Curfew & Attendance:

- Curfew timings must be strictly adhered to. Students who repeatedly violate curfew timings will be subject to warnings, fines, or further disciplinary action.

11. Smoking and Alcohol consumption will lead to immediate rustication

RULES AND REGULATIONS

FOR RESIDING IN THE HOSTEL OF A.U.M.C. (FOR GIRLS ONLY)

12. Mandatory Possession:

Every student residing in the hostel must possess a valid Hostel ID card issued by the hostel administration. Students are required to carry their Hostel ID card at all times within the hostel premises.

13. Entry and Exit:

The Hostel ID card must be presented to the security staff at the hostel entrance upon entry and exit. Students will not be permitted to enter or leave the hostel premises without showing their ID card.

These regulations are designed to promote a safe, secure, and academically conducive environment for all hostel residents. Compliance with these rules is mandatory, and violations will lead to penalties, including possible expulsion from the hostel.



GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The Management and the Principal reserve the right to make additions or alterations to the existing rules, working hours, timetable, or mode of training as may be deemed fit from time to time. The students shall be required to abide by all the prescribed and modified rules.
- Students who are on leave or unable to attend classes due to unforeseen reasons, have to deposit the fees on the due date. Students must attend the lectures on time. Latecomers will not be allowed to attend the classes. Continuous absence for ten days from the college without written permission shall lead to striking off the names of the students from the college. They may readmit with the permission of the principal as a fresh student and he may be required to pay all the dues as a fresh student.
- Students will be responsible individually or collectively (as the case may be) for any loss or damage of institutional property.
- A student is liable to be fined up to Rs. 10000/-suspended, expelled, or dealt with any punishment for negligence in studies/attendance or act of indiscipline or for any misconduct in or out of the college premises, Student found indulged in Anti-Govt... Anti-National or Anti Institution propaganda will be expelled from the college immediately and he/she will have no claim of fees paid by him/her.
- In case of any dispute between the management of the college and the students the matter will fall under the legal jurisdiction of Distt. Aligarh, U.P.
- The Rules, Regulations, and Syllabus in respect of the college printed in the prospectus are given in good faith prevailing at the time of issue of the prospectus.
- The management will be free from all liabilities in case of any change in regulation at any stage. However, in case of any change in the syllabus by NCISM., (New Delhi), the management reserve the right to levy additional charges for the additional study.
- In matters which are not covered in the said rules and regulations, the decision of the Managing Director/Principal shall be final.
- It is the sincere desire and endeavour of the management to make the student good and law-abiding citizens, so as to bring a good name for themselves, family, and the country. If a student indulges in an illegal or anti-national activity the college shall not be responsible for her/his involvement.
- The Management of the College, Principal Unani Colleges reserves this right to cancel or reject any admission form.

DISCIPLINE

The college pursues the ideals of training minds, quest for knowledge and a healthy lifestyle. It developed curiosity and imagination among students and upholds the high tradition of tolerance. It lays great emphasis on mental and physical discipline and expects the students to strictly abide by the rules of progressive discipline inside and outside the classrooms. The Proctor and his staff, Proctorial Monitors selected amongst the students, maintain discipline and security on the campus. Teachers ensure orderly behavior in the college while the wardens in the hostels separately function for girls & boys.

RAGGING

Ragging in any form, as defined in Clause (V) Part 4 of Student Conduct and Discipline Rules is a punishable offense, and a student for this act of indiscipline or ragging, in accordance with clause (V) of the above rules is liable to pay a fine of Rs.5000, which may extend up to Rs. 25000.

The student will have to submit an "undertaking" in the prescribed format to the effect that he or she shall not take part in any form of ragging and shall abide by the rules prescribed for the purpose as amended and enforced from time to time.

FEES

The parent/guardian of each student shall furnish a written undertaking to the effect that he/she will pay all fees due toward his/her ward. If regular payment is not made, the name of the defaulter shall be removed from the roll of the college by the Principal

IMPORTANT INFORMATION & RULES

In this booklet information/rules are given in detail and the students have to abide by all the rules & regulations in spirit and words, seeking admission to this College. The fact that a candidate applies for admission shall be taken to mean that he/she agrees to abide by the college rules. No litigation shall be entertained in this regard.

1. There shall, under no circumstances, be any relaxation in the eligibility criteria.
2. The college reserves the right not to admit any candidate to a course of study even though a notification inviting application for admission to the same has been issued.
3. All admissions shall be provisional.
4. If it is found that the qualifying examination of a candidate is not recognized by the College/Board/University, such admission will be cancelled.
5. Candidates pursuing a course of study at this college or any other university/college are required to get their names removed from the rolls of the concerned university/college and should submit a certificate to this effect from the concerned authority at the time of reporting for admission. An applicant already enrolled in any course/class either at this college or elsewhere is required to get his/her admission to the said course/class cancelled before he/she can be admitted to this Institution/University.
6. No candidate will appear at two examinations simultaneously in one academic year i.e. innd B.U.M.S.
7. Changes made in the admission rules and/or in the eligibility criteria by the Govt's rules & regulation from time to time shall also be applicable to applicants seeking admissions.

8. Candidates are required to produce the original mark sheet, certificates, etc., (document including the statement of marks of the qualifying examination with the requisite percentage of marks) at the time of interview/reporting for admission, failing which they shall not be interviewed/allowed to complete admission, and the offer of admission shall stand cancelled automatically and no further correspondence in the matter shall be entertained.

9. If it is found, at any stage, that a candidate:
- a) Does not fulfill the eligibility requirements;
 - b) Has used fraudulent means to secure admission;
 - c) Has made false or incorrect statements
 - d) Concealed facts

He/she shall not be allowed to appear at the interview, or complete the admission formalities, or if in the case already admitted, his/her admission shall be cancelled.

10. If any error/omission in the course of processing and verification of certificates/documents of any candidate is found by the college, the college has the right to cancel such admission at any stage at which the error is discovered.

11. Applications of candidates whose qualifying examinations are not recognized by the University shall not be considered for admission to any course.

12. Applicants should satisfy themselves that they fulfill the eligibility requirements in terms of educational qualifications, age, etc. The percentage of marks secured by a candidate at the qualifying examination, falling short by even a small fraction shall not be rounded to the next whole number. Similarly, if the age falls short even by a single day, the applicant shall not be considered eligible.

13. No candidate shall be admitted unless he/she has completed all the eligibility requirements at the time of admission. Candidates awaiting the results of their supplementary/compartmetal/improvement examinations shall not be admitted.

14. No employee of any public or private sector organization shall be admitted unless he/she submits a leave sanction order from the competent authority covering the entire duration of the course to which he/she is seeking admission.

15. The college shall intimate the candidates selected for admission to various courses, through registered posts, regarding the dates on which they are to report in person to complete the admission formalities. The College shall bear no responsibility in case of delay or non-delivery of such intimation letters. No information shall be sent to the candidates who are not selected for admission.

16. Canvassing in any manner for securing admission shall render an applicant disqualified.
17. As per the rules, 75% attendance in all courses is compulsory. In case of a long absence of one month from classes, the names of the student shall automatically be removed from the roll.
18. The names of students having attendance less than 75% shall be struck off from the rolls of the college.
19. If after enrolment in the college, a student does not attend his/her classes for more than one month and does not inform the Principal of the college, of the reason for his/her absence, his/her admission shall be automatically cancelled.

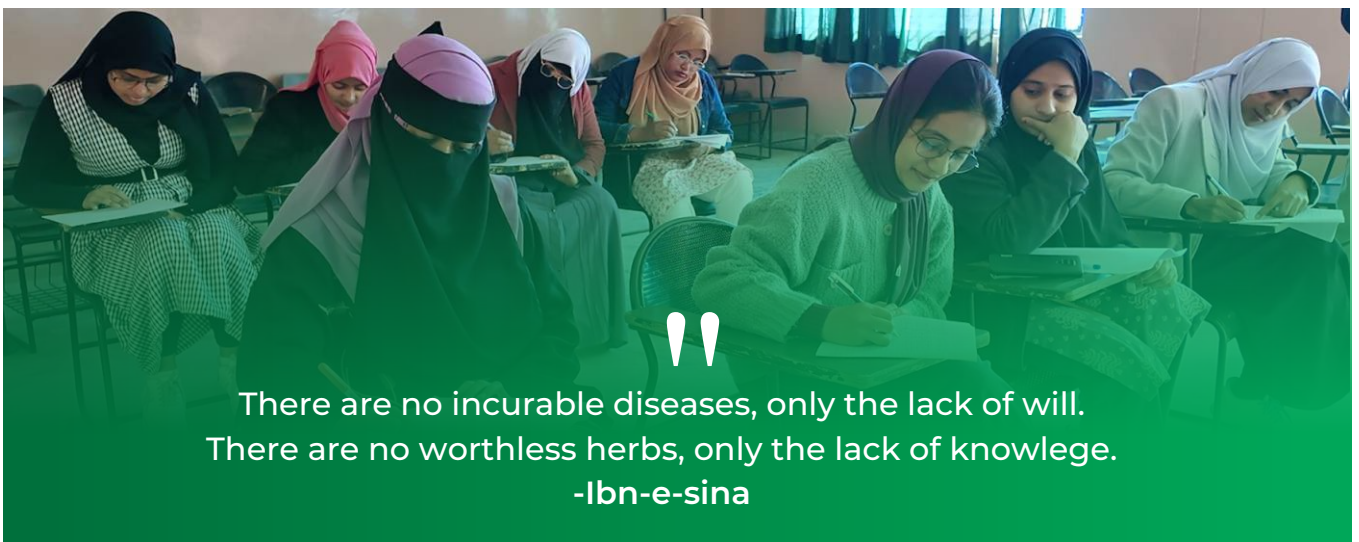
